

Get the Facts Before you Vote August 4, 2015

What is the millage request?

Voters will be asked to approve a millage of up to 0.75 mills for five years beginning in 2016.

How will the community benefit?

- Maintain current levels of bus service
- For most routes:
 - Add daytime **Sunday bus service**
 - Add **extended nighttime hours** for 2nd/3rd shift workers and students
- Increased frequencies on selected heavily used bus routes, reducing wait time for the next bus

How is public transportation funded?

- State Grants —34%
- Property Tax Millages —29%
- Fares —21%
- Federal Grants —14%
- Other —2.5%

The millage is estimated to generate \$3.5 million in 2016. This is important for leveraging State and federal grants.

Why Ask for a Millage?

People depend on public transit services, with **more than 3.2 million rides** provided in 2014—an increase of 20.3% since 2010.

How much will the millage cost me?

The cost of the 0.75 millage request for a homeowner whose home has a market value of \$100,000 (\$50,000 taxable value) is \$37.50 per year—just 10¢ per day.
