

But we did resort to fusible appliqué for the letters and flower stems. The checkerboards scattered around the guilt top add a bit of variety between the large backaround blocks. Even if we did use different colors than we normally do, the Country flavor still comes shining through.





Home Energy Audit



Black Lentil & Butternut Squash Curry




- One pint of homemade vegan curry (frozen)




