

## Summary of race, gender and sexual orientation data

### Gender:

Female (and variations): 85 – 66%

Male (and variations): 39 – 30%

Trans man: 3 – 2%

Gender fluid / nonbinary: 2 -2%

### Race:

White (and variations): 122 – 95%

Mixed / biracial: 4 – 3%

Latino: 1 – 1%

Human: 1 – 1%

### Sexual Orientation

(This data is messy. About 10% of the answers given were gender terms, like cis or female.

Some folks put more than one word like 'gay / queer.' I did my best.)

Heterosexual (and variations): 85 – 76%

Bisexual / Pansexual: 10 – 9%

Gay: 4 – 4%

Queer: 4 – 4%

Don't know yet: 2 – 2%

Lesbian: 2 – 2%

Straightish: 2 -2%

Asexual: 1 -1%

Monogamous: 1 - 1%
