 - Elevator cost went over budget
 - County property tax continues this year due to fiscal year differences, apprx \$1200, should be last time this is charged to the church
 - No major concern about financial solvency at the moment
- 2. Investment Committee (Greg Feldmeier)
 - 10% of stocks invested were put into ESG (Environmental, Social and Governance) funds at the last investment meeting, which is about \$30,000 of \$600,000 total invested (5% of total)
 - Greg can return in January to give financial report in person or in writing
